  - Used library volunteers to help with some of the questions.
- All questions were asked with either the author or the book title as the answer.
  - Worked on memorization.

### How we changed it!

- We created a partnership with Lakehead University Faculty of Education.
  - They chose half the book list.
  - Helped make questions.
  - Helped decide new format.
  - Assisted with mock battle presentations.




















### Introduced the new Plan




