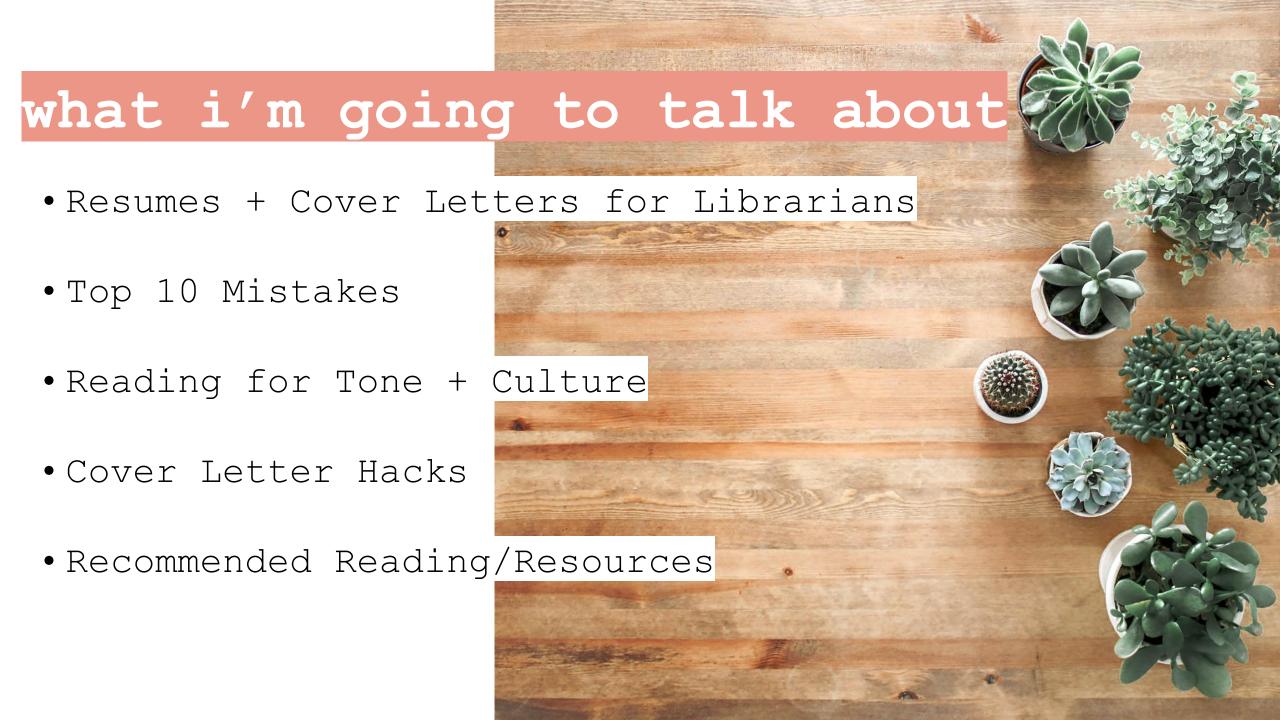

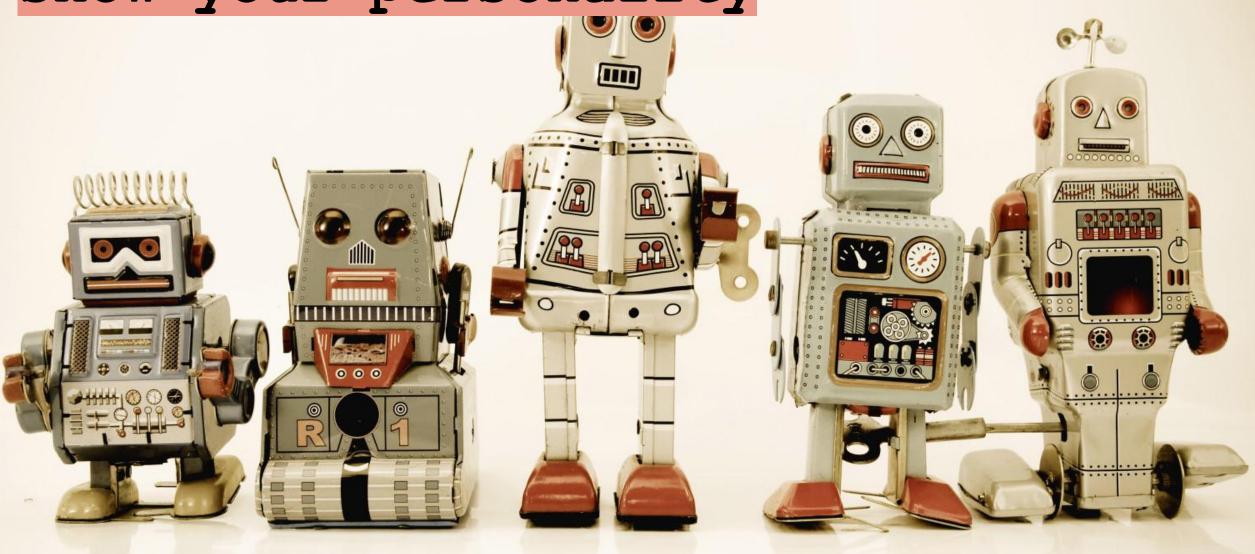

Understand

- The job
- The organization
- Your own skills + applicability to both of these

TL.DR (too long/didn't read)
```

so how long should it be?

- Good question!
- ... and it depends :)



graphically unnotable

don't (just) use a template

Demonstrate:

- technical skills
- you know more than Word
- some personality



not doing your research.



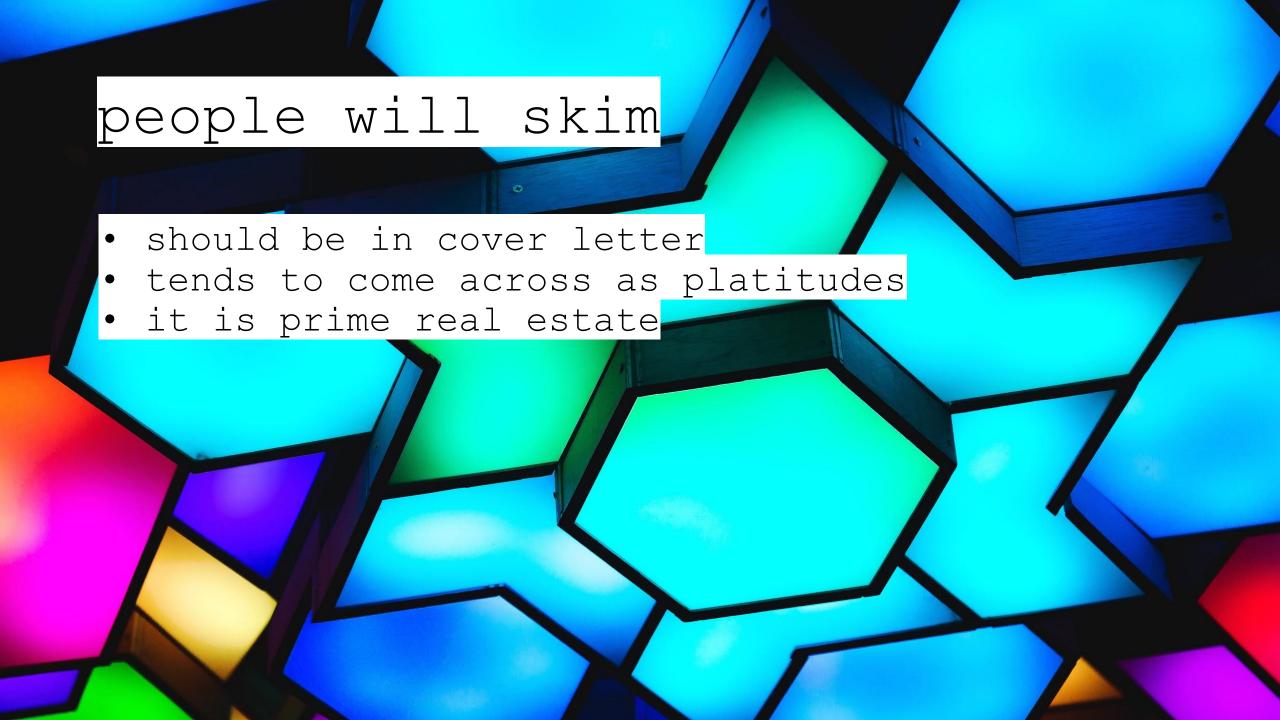
do your research

- What are the requirements and qualifications?
- What defines that organization/institution?

```
repeating your resume in your cover letter.
```



```
wasting space with an objective/profile statement.
```



not following instructions.

asked for a PDF? don't send a word file

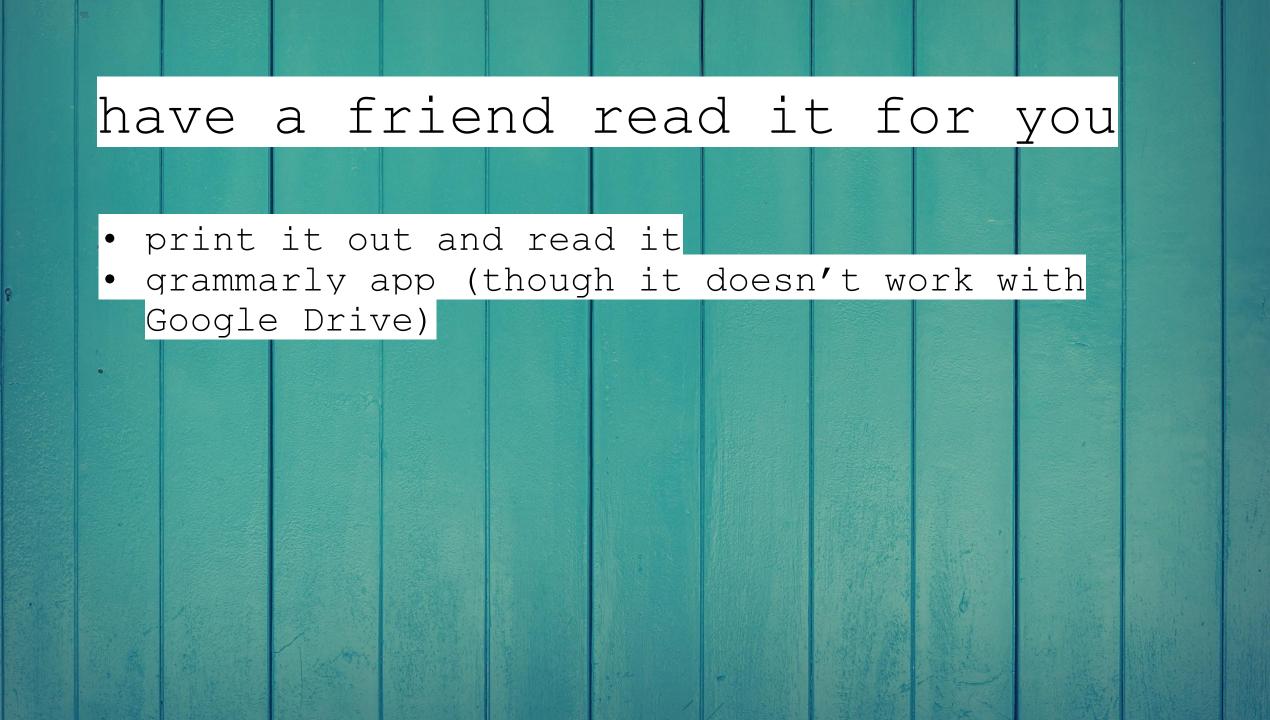
- file naming, file type
- 1 file?
- email subject line
- read carefully and double check



too generic.

take the time to customize each application thiss must be the place

```
tTypos (not paying attention to the details)
```

highlighting duties instead of accomplishments.

not just what you did, but how well

- Did you answer customer questions or did you receive a top 10% rating in customer surveys?
- Co-op: plan events, engagement online

interpreting digital identity for job seeking

How do you get to know an organization you have never been to?



What should you look at?

- Explore their website
- Explore their social media
- Look forprogramming,services, events
- Identify key staff

Activity #1: Getting to know an organization

Things to look at and look for:

- What are their services? Programming?
- What type of language do they use?
- What does their social media look like?
- Do they have a specific focus/area of expertise?
- What is the background of the people that work there?
- Do they have an aesthetic?
- Large Public vs. small college vs. provincial organization
- Have they been in the news? (try google news or Canadian Newsstand (a library database)

How can we use this information?

- In your cover letter:
 - recognize the needs of the organization + respond to it
- Demonstrate that you know about them
- Where do you fit + how can you help?
- Understanding of the language, culture, and aesthetic of the organization

don't forget non-library work





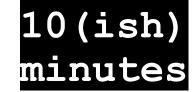
design for skimming

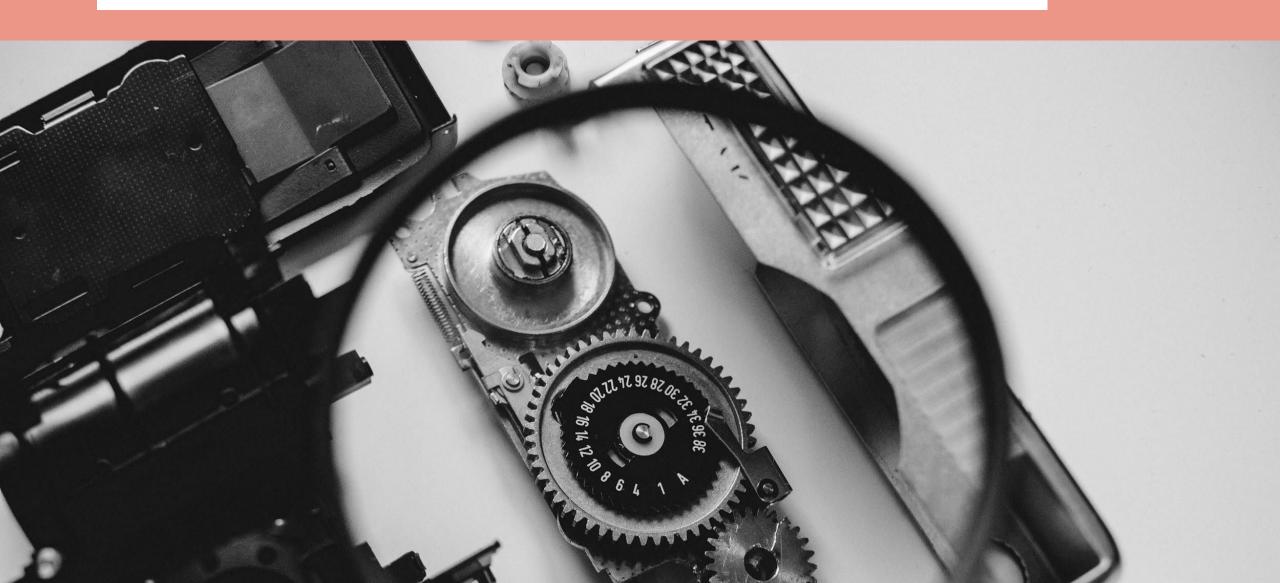
- Will depend on the organization and job posting

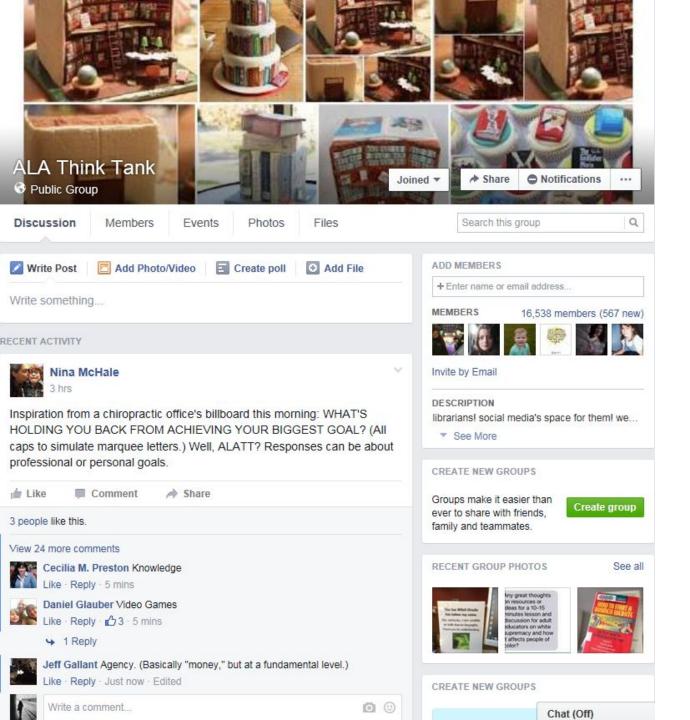

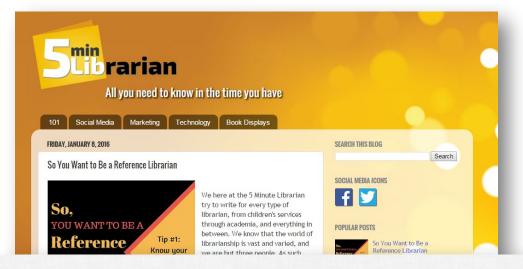
